Quarterly

Process

The committee will consider the campus's strategic response to changing circumstances for existing and planned capital projects (e.g., unanticipated costs, etc.) and the emergence of new opportunities (e.g., unexpected donor interest, new RFPS, state mandates, etc.) in the broader context of established priorities, existing commitments, emerging goals, and the overall campus budget.

The Provost will set the agenda for discussion, with input from stakeholders. In turn, the Executive Director and for Facilities and Services and the Assistant Provost for Capital Planning will prepare background information for discussion, including potential options.

Final decisions rest with the Chancellor and the Provost.
