To redeem your waiver:

- Log into the <u>Cooperating Personnel</u> <u>Portal.</u>
- 2. Click on Waivers.

Select: "Review your waiver information or redeem your waiver."

- Please note the first bullet point: "Waivers redeemed today will be applied to your [insert current semester] bill". When redeeming a waiver, they will <u>always apply to the current semester reflected on</u> <u>the portal</u>. Meaning if you redeem your waiver while it is currently Fall semester it will apply to your Fall semester tuition.

Important money saving tips! Before redeeming a waiver be aware that:

• Waivers redeemed today will be applied to your **Spring 2023** bill.

Make sure to verify the waiver can apply to courses in which you enroll.

- Programs may restrict the use of Cooperating Teacher waivers for some courses. Waivers cannot be used for:
 - Courses in approved cost-recovery or self-supporting programs. Ensure your program is not in this list of programs your waiver will not apply.
 - Self-supporting courses. These courses are typically identified in the class schedule as self-supporting. It is your responsibility to identify if you are in a self-supporting program and/or registered in a self-supporting course.
- Waivers transferred to the University of Illinois at Springfield are only redeemable for 4 credit hours of tuition and fees.
- Fees not covered by the waiver:
 - Health Insurance fees (\$900+) will be automatically assessed and are not covered by the waiver. It may be possible to receive an exemption. Warning: Insurance
 Exemption Waiver period closes shortly after beginning of semester. Learn how to request an exemption for the Health Insurance fee or call the Student Insurance
 Office at (217) 333-0165.
 - Laboratory or other fees incurred as part of a course are not covered by the waiver.

4. You will see a list of your waivers. The view button lets you see a waiver's history. While in view mode you cannot redeem your waiver.

5. To redeem your waiver, select the redeem button.
